For example, their intuitive design and one-hand operation allows for easy selection between OFF, Generator, and one or two Shore Power sources.

Like all Blue Sea Systems products, each **AC Rotary Switch Source Selector** is manufactured to exacting standards, for dependable performance in the harsh marine environment. Each is ruggedly built using heavy-duty industrial rated switches and a sturdy, easy-to-grab switch selector mechanism.

Blue Sea Systems' **AC Rotary Switch Source Selectors** are available in six configurations (12 models total) ranging from two, three or four pole with two or three positions, plus OFF. These selectors are rated to either 32/65 maximum Amperes, 600 maximum Volts AC and are designed to switch combinations of one/two/three 120V/240V or 230V European AC sources.

Blue Sea Systems offers a variety of models for different marine electrical system applications, including both stand-alone switches (designed for mounting in panels up to 0.16"/4.00mm thick) and models integrated into the company's **AC Source Selection Panels**. All **AC Source Selection Panels** utilize red reverse polarity indicating LEDs, green LEDs indicating power availability and accept standard Blue Sea Systems labels for easy source identification.
