



BLUE SEA SYSTEMS INTRODUCES NEW HD (HEAVY-DUTY) BATTERY SWITCH
THAT'S RUGGED AND AFFORDABLE

Blue Sea Systems has introduced a new heavy-duty marine battery switch designed to meet the DC high amperage power management needs of today's boats with diesel engines, inverters, bow thrusters and large battery banks.

Blue Sea System's new American-made HD Battery Switch is rated for 550 continuous amps (900 amps intermittent) and is built to Blue Sea's strict standards for performance and durability. The company's guarantee is to stand behind its product for as long as you own it, which is the boater's assurance of long-lasting quality.

Yet, with a base MSRP of only \$69.95, the new HD Battery Switch is actually less expensive than comparable switches from other manufacturers. This new two-position switch comes in two versions - standard Model 3000 and Model 3001 which offers Alternator Field Disconnect (AFD), a feature that prevents electrical system damage if the selector is accidentally switched to OFF with the engine running.

Blue Sea Systems leveraged many of the features of the popular 9000e battery switch when they designed the HD Battery Switch. Both models accept up to 4/0-battery cables with three cable entry directions. And the HD Battery Switch features a luminous label on the face that makes it easy to determine position at a glance, even in the dark recesses of a bilge compartment or engine room. In addition, the battery switches are designed to be panel- or surface-mounted for versatile installation.

Both models are built with features and heavy-duty construction not found on competitive switches. For example, 1/2" tin-plated copper studs are used to optimize conductivity and increase corrosion resistance. Their compact design requires only 15 square inches of space for mounting (less than other comparable heavy-duty switches) allowing for installation in even the tightest quarters. Of course, Blue Sea Systems' HD Battery Switch is ignition protected so it is approved for use on gasoline-powered boats.
